

Sandsend Conservation Area

Sandsend is an area of special architectural and historic interest which was designated as a Conservation Area in 1974 by the former North Riding County Council.

The majority of the Conservation Area now falls within the administrative boundary of Scarborough Borough Council, a very small proportion falls within that of the North York Moors National Park.

The character or appearance of such an area is desirable to preserve or enhance.

It is the Borough Council's responsibility to ensure that any new development should fit in with the existing conservation area. As an aid the Council carried out a Character Appraisal and Management Plan. The following plan was updated in 2011.
